As part of the United States' pivot to  Asia, the U. S. has formed a pact known as the Quad Alliance, comprised of four Indo-Pacific nations--U.S., Japan, India, and Australia--in order to build cooperative defense relations, develop anti-terrorism strategies and to counter China's role in the region.

Our speaker for the 2022 Kickoff Event and Annual Meeting is Lisa Curtis, a foreign policy and national security expert with over twenty years of service in the U.S. government, and as an analyst and advisor to the NSC, CIA, State Department, and Capitol Hill. She formerly served as Senior Director for South and Central Asia with the National Security Council from 2017 to 2021.

Ms. Curtis will delve into the Quad Alliance by looking at the underlying reasons for such an alliance, and the challenges that the region must address in the next few years.
